VALLEY VIEW CHARTER PREP GRANTED MAXIMUM ACCREDITATION

Sacramento, CA, May 15, 2018 – Pacific Charter Institute applauds Valley View Charter Prep for receiving a six-year accreditation by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). WASC is the organization that provides accreditation to both public and private K-12 and post-secondary schools. A six-year accreditation is the maximum term offered and reflects the highest confidence in the quality of school operations, academics, and service to families. The process involved a self-study followed by a multi-day visit from a WASC visiting committee of specially trained education professions.

Since 2014, Valley View Charter Prep has supported home-based independent study students in San Joaquin and adjacent counties including Alameda, Amador, Calaveras, Contra Costa, Santa Clara, and Stanislaus. It is one of four public charter schools in the region supported by Pacific Charter Institute, a nonprofit organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and serving in the region since 2006.
