Proposal submissions should cite the associated FCC Form 470 number and applicant name (Pacific Charter School) in the subject line.

Proposals must include all costs associated with providing service, including but not limited to:

- monthly service fees
- managed router/modem lease fees (if required for service to function)
- one-time construction, installation, and/or connection charges
- estimated taxes, fees, and/or surcharges
- all ineligible costs must be clearly identified

All contracts must allow for bandwidth increases up to 10 Gbps throughout the term of the contract.

Pacific Charter Institute may at any time, at its sole discretion add, change, or delete any of the eligible services requested above.

SPAM and/or robotic responses will not be considered valid bid responses and will be disqualified from consideration.

Proposals that do not provide definitive costs for the services requested (including recurring and/or one-time charges) will be considered non-responsive and will not be included in the evaluation.

Proposals that include generic/encyclopedic price lists will be considered non-responsive and will not be

included in the evaluation.

Proposals requiring applicant-owned hardware in order to function must provide specifications and, if

available, an estimated cost for necessary hardware.

Proposals should include the service provider's terms and conditions.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS: Quantities are estimates and may increase or decrease over the term of the awarded contract.

State and Local Requirements

Applicant may consider multi-year and/or contracts with voluntary extensions. Any voluntary contract extensions must be identified within the awarded contract and must be of a specified number and duration. Contracts with automatic or evergreen contract extension terms will not be considered. Applicant may consider contracts with flexible terms to allow for growth/reduction in services to accommodate an increase/decrease in the number of sites, users, and/or bandwidth.
