1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded.

Rio Valley Charter School Resource Centers | Art & Enrichment Overview, 2025–2026

Rio Valley Charter School provided in-person art and enrichment programming across the **Elk Grove, Broadway, and Lodi Resource Centers**. The three centers were supported by **two full-time teachers**, with Elk Grove and Broadway sharing one teacher and Lodi supported by one teacher, in addition to site assistants, instructional aides, and site management.

Elk Grove Resource Center

- Approximately **28 high school students** participated in a weekly Art 1 course.
- An additional **70–90 TK–8 students participated in weekly art instruction**.
- Students explored art movements, famous artists, artistic vocabulary, and a variety of mediums, including **drawing, painting, sculpture, mixed media, and comic art**.
- High school students also completed **research, writing, and presentation assignments** connected to the visual arts.

Broadway/Lodi Resource Center Programming

- Structured art instruction served approximately **20 middle and high school students**, including **7 middle school and 13 high school students**.
- Projects included **album cover redesign, optical illusion art, famous artwork recreation, photography, one-line portraits, mixed-media pieces, visual metaphor paintings, environmental art, community portrait projects, murals, and portfolio development**.
- More than **40 students participated in formal art classes**, with additional students engaging in enrichment activities throughout the year.

Schoolwide Enrichment

Site staff extended art beyond scheduled classes through **monthly and seasonal community art projects**, including collaborative displays, themed artwork, mixed-media activities, Mother's Day projects, murals, and an annual **Art Showcase**. These activities provided students with additional opportunities for creativity, connection, and in-person engagement at Rio Valley's resource centers.
