1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded.
Sutter Peak Charter Academy's Prop 28 Arts Education Program provided students with consistent access to visual arts and creative learning opportunities throughout the school year. The program offered 12 classes each week for students in TK through 12th grade. Elementary students participated in age-appropriate visual arts classes, while middle school students received dedicated arts instruction and high school students had opportunities to participate in Intro to Visual Art and Leadership/Yearbook classes.

The program also provided students with meaningful opportunities to create and contribute to the school community. Additional activities included taking yearbook portrait photographs at Fun Friday events and a senior event, compiling the school yearbook, and coordinating its distribution to students and families at the end of the school year. Through these activities, Prop 28 funding expanded students' access to arts education while supporting creativity, collaboration, leadership, and school community engagement.
