

### THE JOURNEY IT'S MORE THAN JUST YOUR ABC'S

PRINT CONCEPTS **ALPHABETIC SYSTEM** PHONEMIC AWARENESS COMPREHENSION VOCABULARY **PHONICS** DECODING



As children grasp that every sound has a picture, we start teaching the basic ABC's. Easy peasy, right? Well, for some it is, but for many of us, it is hard work.

#### **Consider this:**

- 26 Letter Names
- 26 Letter Symbols
- 26 Letter Sounds
- Vowel Long and Short Sounds
- Upper and Lower Cases
- Multiple Fonts

English also does not make things easy as one bridges into words beyond those like c-a-t. For example, how many ways can you write the sound "k" or "shun"?

### TIPS AND TRICKS

As your child begins independent reading, make it a topic for daily meal time discussion.

Electronics
make it easier to
identify letters on a
screen rather than
creating them. Early
learners can practice
tracing letters and
even making them in
shaving cream.

Read together daily, not only in your curriculum activities, but as a shared leisurely activity.

Be careful not to unintentionally add extra sounds to single letters.

(P is not puh; but mostly a puff of air.)

Always turn the Closed Captioning on when your child watches video.

TRY CHUNKING...

### CHUNKING

- USE A PENCIL TO MARK THE WORD INTO CHUNKS
- LOOK FOR ANY FAMILIAR PIECES OF THE WORD
- EACH SYLLABLE OR KNOWN PARTS SHOULD BE A CHUNK
- TRY TO START EACH CHUNK WITH A CONSONANT
- ONE VOWEL SOUND PER CHUNK
- CHUNKS CAN BE SOUNDED OUT AND THEN BLENDED TOGETHER
- SAY THE WORD ALOUD DOES IT SOUND CORRECT?
